









~~MUCOCOELE CYSTIC LESION: IT IS A FLUID FILLED CAVITY WITH A THIN WALL, OFTEN OCCURRING IN THE LOWER LIP, BUT ALSO IN THE UPPER LIP, CHEEK, AND TONGUE. IT IS CAUSED BY A BLOCKAGE OF A SALIVARY GLAND DUCT, WHICH LEADS TO THE ACCUMULATION OF SALIVA. IT IS A BENIGN LESION, BUT IT CAN BE PAINFUL AND IT CAN GROW LARGER. IT IS TREATED BY EXCISION OR BY ASPIRATION.~~
