



Pemphigus Vegetans

Pemphigus vegetans is an uncommon variant of pemphigus vulgaris, comprising only 1 % to 2% of cases

Histopathology.

In the Neumann type, the early lesions consist of bullae and denuded areas that have the same

histologic picture as that of pemphigus vulgaris. As the lesions age, however, there is formation

of villi and verrucous epidermal hyperplasia. Numerous eosinophils are present within the

epidermis and dermis
