X-linked ichthyosis is recessively inherited, with about 90% caused by gene deletion. It is only rarely pre

Histopathology.

In hyperkeratosis, the granular layer is normal or slightly thickened but not thinned as in dominant ichthyosis

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Histogenesis .

X-linked ichthyosis, like ichthyosis vulgaris, shows a normal rate of epidermal proliferation. The disorder is a retention hyperkeratosis characterized by delayed dissolution of the desmosomal disks in the horny layer.
